Giving students jobs at recess will promote a positive play culture and empower them to create their own safe and healthy recess. Here are a few ideas for student jobs at recess:

□ Rock Paper Scissors Rockstar

This rockstar is in charge of reminding people to play Rock Paper Scissors when there is a disagreement in a game. No disagreements? Their role is to walk around and challenge other students to Rock Paper Scissors.

☐ Lightning Lingo Rockstar:

This rockstar is in charge of bringing the positive voice and spreading the "Good job!" and "Nice try!" mantra throughout the game they are playing.

□ Equipment Rockstar:

This rockstar is in charge of bringing the equipment out to recess and cleaning up after recess is over.
